

## **RESOLUTION 2020-084**

### **RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO REALLOCATE \$30,000 IN FY 18/19 GENERAL FUND DESIGNATED RESERVES (HILLSIDE & GEOTECH STUDIES / IMPROVEMENTS) FROM THE SAN PABLO DAM ROAD HILLSIDE STABILIZATION PROJECT (0400) TO THE PRINCETON PLAZA PROJECT (0402)**

WHEREAS, this project is exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act as a funding action which is not a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) as it is not an activity that may cause a direct or reasonably foreseeable indirect physical environment change pursuant to Public Resources Code section 21080(a) and 14 California Code of Regulations section 15002(d);

WHEREAS, Resolution 2019-017 adopted on February 4<sup>th</sup>, 2019, \$176,599 in FY 18/19 General Fund Designated Reserves was set aside for Hillside Stabilization & Geo-Tech Studies/Improvements, which in May 2019 through Resolution 2019-061 were appropriated to the San Pablo Dam Road Hillside Stabilization Project in anticipation of assessment and preliminary design of stabilization of San Pablo Dam Road between Amador Street and the Princeton Plaza Shopping Center;

WHEREAS, the Princeton Plaza hillside has historically experienced slide activity, and warrants ongoing monitoring;

WHEREAS, repairs of portions of the hillside have occurred over a number of decades, and inclinometers and piezometers have been installed to monitor any ongoing slope movement and hydraulic soil pressures;

WHEREAS, in October 2019, pursuant to Resolution 2019-155, a portion of this money (\$20,000) was reallocated for two years of monitoring of the hillside between Hillcrest Drive and Princeton Plaza leaving a balance of \$156,599 for the San Pablo Dam Road;

WHEREAS, in December 2019, the City received a proposal from on-call geotechnical consultant Miller Pacific Engineering Group to replace several inclinometers, including new piezometers and data loggers, that had been sheared off and no longer providing reliable data;

WHEREAS, the proposal exceeds the current funding available for the Princeton Plaza Project; and

WHEREAS, City staff requests to reallocate an additional \$30,000 from the San Pablo Dam Road Hillside Stabilization Project to the Princeton Plaza Project in order to conduct appropriate monitoring on the hillside.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of San Pablo hereby authorizes the City Manager to reallocate \$30,000 in FY 18/19 General Fund Designated Reserves from the San Pablo Dam Road Hillside Stabilization Project (old account code is 320-3200-43600-SPD-400; new account code is 320-0400-43602-GFD-419) to the Princeton Plaza Project (320-0402-43602-GFD-419).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct and are included herein by reference as findings.
