## **RESOLUTION 2020-###**

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF SAN PABLO TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE \$54,000 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM TO CONDUCT TRAFFIC SAFETY ENFORCEMENT OPERATIONS TO REDUCE THE NUMBER OF PERSONS KILLED AND INJURED IN TRAFFIC COLLISIONS INVOLVING ALCOHOL OR OTHER PRIMARY COLLISION FACTORS AND RATIFYING THE CITY MANAGER'S EXECUTION OF THE GRANT AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, Traffic Safety Program is an adopted policy item under the FY 2019-21 Council Priority Work Plan, effective March 1, 2019 and most recently amended May 18, 2020;

WHEREAS, this is not a project as defined by CEQA;

WHEREAS, there are 61 licensed alcohol outlets in the City of San Pablo. The majority of problem alcohol establishments are concentrated in areas that have both the highest crime rate and the greatest number of off-premise sales;

WHEREAS, historically, the San Pablo Police Department has a concerning number of DUI arrests, which is partly due to the number of alcohol establishments in town;

WHEREAS, currently there is not a sufficient number of officers with specialized training in Standardized Field Sobriety Testing (SFST), Advanced Roadside Impaired Driving Enforcement (ARIDE), Drug Abuse Recognition (DAR) and Basic Collision Investigation; and not a single officer possesses a Drug Recognition Expert Certification (DRE);

WHEREAS, the San Pablo Police Department was selected by the Office of Traffic Safety (OTS) for funding and to participate in the "Selective Traffic Enforcement Program" (STEP). The total amount of provided grant funding is \$54,000;

WHEREAS, grant funds are provided to facilitate specialized training related to traffic safety enforcement and investigation; conduct traffic enforcement operations; and conduct traffic safety educational presentations to community members; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Pablo supports the grant goals and wishes to participate in the grant program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the foregoing recitations are true and correct, and are included herein by reference as findings.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City to accept the grant, ratifies the City Manager's execution of the grant agreement, and appropriates funds anticipated to be received from the Office of Traffic Safety to be used exclusively for the purpose of funding operational enforcement, training, and educational outreach related to Traffic Safety and Enforcement as set forth below:
