
City Council COVID-19 Housing Assistance Grant Program Update



Housing Grant Program



- On May 4, 2020, City Council approved the program.
- Funded by \$250k in Low Income Housing Funds.
- City received 210 applications.
 - 100 approved.
 - 31 missing documents
 - 79 denied.
- \$115k in potential benefit.
- Staff is recommending the benefit to a maximum of \$2k per household.

Housing Grant Program



- Previous Grant Program ended on May 31, 2020.
- County Shelter in Place continues to be in place.
- Effects of the COVID-19 continue to be felt by San Pablo residents particularly our lower income population.
- Establishment of a new COVID-19 Housing Grant Program for Fiscal Year 2020/21
 - ▶ Funded by \$250k in FY 20/21 Low Income Housing Funds.
 - Benefits of up to \$1k per household.
 - Benefits based on income levels and household size.
 - First come first served basis.
 - > Households who have previously received grant monies do not qualify.
 - Program begins on July 1, 2020 and ends on September 30, 2020 or until program funds run out, whichever is sooner.
