# ROLL CALL

The video/teleconferenced meeting convened at 12:01 pm. Present were Mayor Rita Xavier, Vice Mayor Abel Pineda and Councilmembers Patricia Ponce, Arturo Cruz and Elizabeth Pabon-Alvarado. Also present were City Manager Matt Rodriguez, City Attorney Teresa Stricker, Assistant City Manager Charles Ching, City Clerk Dorothy Gantt, and Deputy City Clerk Lehny Corbin.

Mayor Xavier announced that the City Council previously determined to meet remotely pursuant to Assembly Bill 361, and that the Council's findings are memorialized in Consent Calendar item #3.

A pre-recorded announcement was played indicating that the meeting was being held via video/teleconference in accordance with the Brown Act as currently in effect under the Governor's Emergency Declaration related to COVID-19 that allow members of the City Council, City staff and the public to participate and conduct a meeting by teleconference, videoconference or both. The announcement indicated the ways in which members of the public may watch or listen to the meeting during livestream on the City website. Instructions were also announced that the public might provide public comments via email, which would be read before Council consideration of the item.

City Clerk Gantt read aloud the comments submitted by Cordell Hindler who asked the Council to invite Jasmine Tarkoff to provide a report on the new initiative for affordable housing, and Sabrina Landreth to update on how park services have been affected by the pandemic.
