RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN PABLO AUTHORIZING A TRANSFER OF \$107,000 FOR PRE-DEVELOPMENT WORK ON THE FORMER EL PORTAL SCHOOL SITE LOCATED AT 2600 MORAGA ROAD FROM THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT BUDGET (100-1320-43600-EPS-000) TO THE CIP BUDGET (320-3200-44000-EPS-000)

BACKGROUND

On July 20, 2015, City Council adopted resolution 2015-128 appropriating \$150,000 from FY 2015/16 General Fund Designated Reserves / City-wide Economic Development Projects to Economic Development Professional Services (100-1320-43600-EPS-000) to fund pre-development work on the former El Portal school site located at 2600 Moraga Road (El Portal). Of that amount, approximately \$43,000 has been expended and/or encumbered to date as follows:

<u>Description / Contract</u>	<u>Amount</u>
Topo and Survey work on El Portal	\$ 17,350
Architectural Services on El Portal	\$ 25,000

The City continues the pre-development work on El Portal. For ease of administration, the proposed resolution authorizes the transfer of the remaining monies in the amount of \$107,000 into a project budget in the CIP (320-3200-44000-EPS-000).

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed resolution will transfer \$107,000 from the Economic Development operating budget (100-1320-43600-EPS-000) to the CIP project budget (320-3200-44000-EPS-000).
