BACKGROUND

The City Council Priority Workplan (Workplan) is an annual policy making document established by majority vote of the City Council for purposes of providing policy direction for implementation by the City Manager. Once adopted, the City Manager can direct City resources and staffing toward adopted policy areas/items. Periodic amendments are made following adoption throughout the FY period by Resolution of the City Council. Currently, the FY 2018-21 Council Priority Workplan was adopted by Resolution No. 2017-213, and became effective November 1, 2017.
